Relief goods transport with food, 120 first aid kits with medicine, clothing, blankets, hygiene articles for the care of refugees at the Romanian/Ukrainian border – inside the House of Capuchins and in a reception camp with about 3000 people on the Ukrainian side.



Three Ukrainian women and their children, who are accommodated from our sisters, are supported in everything (care, assistance with food purchases and clothing, visits to authorities etc.). Here they are enjoying an outing with our sisters.



Support of relief transport from the “catholic Kolping Family Organization” with food, medicine sets, clothing for children/adults as well as other relief supplies for a drop-in center in Chernivtsi, with a kitchen that serves 400 - 500 people daily.
